


### Burlington gasoline distributors more than tripled their profit margins during the first half of 2012.

• From January 1st to June 24th of this year, gas station distributors in Burlington more than tripled their profit margins – making a profit of 16.3 cents a gallon during the week of January 1st (about 5 cents higher than the national average) to a profit of 57.9 cents a gallon during the week of June 24<sup>th</sup> (more than two times the national average of 27.4 cents a gallon).



### St. Albans gasoline distributors more than tripled their profit margins during the first half of this year.

• From January 1st to June 24th of this year, gas station distributors in St. Albans more than tripled their profit margins – making a profit of 18.9 cents a gallon during the week of January 1st to a profit of 57.2 cents a gallon during the week of June 24th.



# Waterbury gasoline distributors saw their profit margins more than triple during the first half of this year.

• From January 1st to June 24th of this year, gas station distributors in Waterbury saw their profit margins more than triple – making a profit of 17.9 cents a gallon during the week of January 1st to a profit of 57.5 cents a gallon during the week of June 24<sup>th</sup>.
